

NOTICE SETTING HEARING FOR TEMPORARY ORDERS

Hearing is hereby set for Temporary Orders in the 416th Judicial District Court in the Collin County Courthouse located at 210 S. McDonald Street, McKinney, Texas 75069, on _____ **at 9:00 a.m.** The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether, during the pendency of this case:

1. Petitioner should be awarded the exclusive use and possession of the parties' residence, furniture, and furnishings during the pendency of this suit, and Respondent should be enjoined from entering or remaining on the premises of the residence, except as authorized by order of this Court.
2. Petitioner should be awarded exclusive use and control of the <TYPE OF CAR> motor vehicle, and Respondent should be enjoined from entering, operating, or exercising control over it.
3. Petitioner should be appointed temporary Joint Managing Conservator.
4. Respondent should be ordered to pay child support, health insurance premiums for coverage on the <child or children>, and the <child or children>'s uninsured medical expenses while this case is pending.
5. The Court should order the preparation of a social study into the circumstances and condition of the <child or children> and of the home of any person requesting managing conservatorship or possession of the children.
6. The Court should order the psychological evaluation of <RESP NAME> and the <child or children>.
7. The Court should order the parties to attend a parent education and family stabilization course.
8. The Court should appoint an *Amicus* Attorney.
9. The Court should order Respondent to pay support to Petitioner until a final decree is signed.
10. The Court should order Respondent to produce copies of income tax returns for tax years <YEARS>, a financial statement, and current pay stubs by a date certain.
11. The Court should order Respondent to pay reasonable interim attorney's fees

and expenses.

12. The Court should order Respondent to file a sworn inventory and appraisal of all the separate and community property owned or claimed by the parties and all debts and liabilities owed by the parties in the form and detail prescribed by the *Texas Family Law Practice Manual* (2d ed.), form 7-1.
13. The Court should order Respondent to participate in an alternative dispute resolution process before trial of this matter.
14. The Court should order Respondent to execute all necessary releases required by Petitioner to obtain any discovery allowed by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.
15. The Court should order a pretrial conference to simplify the issues in this case and determine the stipulations of the parties and for any other matters the Court deems appropriate.
16. The Court should make such other and further orders respecting the property and the parties as pleaded for or as may be deemed necessary and equitable and for the safety and welfare of the <child or children>.
