Why the Honoree is receiving a GEM Award including dates:

I, Steve Scales, Supervisor, Collin County CSCD would like to recommend that Mr. Andy Nation receive a GEM award for his participation in facilitating a Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT) class in the Sheriff's Convicted ReEntry Effort (SCORE Program). MRT is a cognitive behavioral program "designed to enhance self image, promote growth of a positive identity, and facilitate the development of higher stages of moral reasoning." MRT is evidence based and research shows that MRT is effective in reducing rearrests and reincarceration of offenders. Earlier this year, Collin County CSCD decided to make MRT one of the core classes in the SCORE Program. At that time, Mr. Nation volunteered to be trained as an MRT facilitator and facilitate a class in SCORE. He completed the 32 hour facilitator training in September of 2013 and since that time he has been facilitating an MRT group. Mr Nation has taken on this additional task while maintaining all of her regular job duties and functions. Being an MRT facilitator requires several hours weekly preparing course material and facilitating the group. As stated earlier, his participation in MRT is voluntary and in addition to his regular job duties. His participation in MRT exhibits his unselfish dedication and commitment to service.
